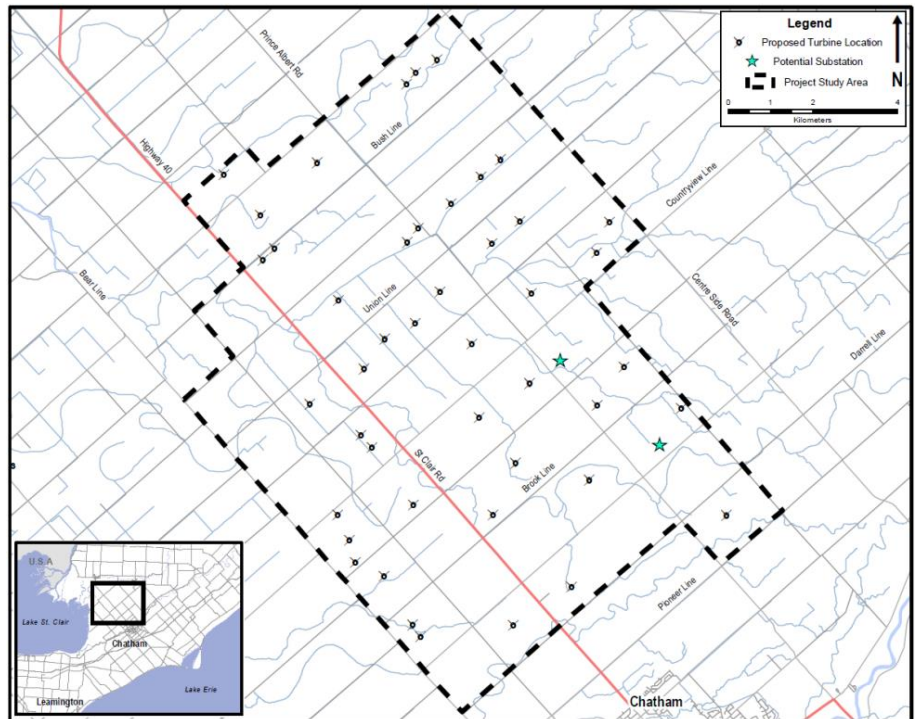


Project Overview

The North Kent Wind Project (the “Project”) is a 100 megawatt wind facility located north of Chatham in the Municipality of Chatham-Kent, Ontario. The Project was developed by North Kent Wind 1 LP, by its general partner, North Kent Wind 1 GP Inc. (“North Kent Wind”), which obtained Renewable Energy Approval (“REA”) from the Ministry of the Environment and Climate Change (“MOECC”) to build a Class 4 Wind facility in June 2016. The Project completed construction and has been operating since February, 2018.

Purpose of the Community Liaison Committee

The Project established a Community Liaison Committee (CLC) to discuss various aspects, including construction, installation, use, operation, maintenance and retirement of the Project. The CLC is not intended to revisit matters already addressed through the REA process. As such, CLC meetings will serve as a forum to share ideas, provide the community with ongoing updates about the Project, and address any concerns the community may have.
