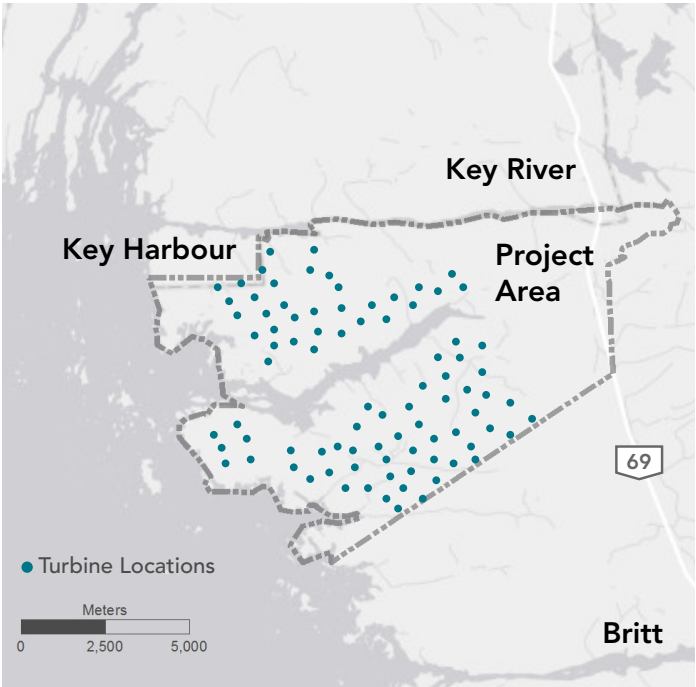




About Henvey Inlet Wind

In 2014, Henvey Inlet First Nation - through its wholly-owned subsidiary Nigig Power Corporation - partnered with Pattern Development to jointly develop and construct the 300 MW Henvey Inlet Wind project. This project is a one-of-a-kind venture. It is both the largest wind project in Ontario, as well as the largest First Nation wind partnership project in Canada.

Construction on the Henvey Inlet Wind project began in 2017. More than 800 jobs are currently on-site during peak construction activity. Once operational, it will generate more than \$10 million every year for Henvey Inlet First Nation to invest in their economy and produce clean energy equal to the electricity needs of 100,000 Ontario homes.

Harvesting the Wind for a More Prosperous First Nation

The Henvey Inlet Wind project is creating many economic benefits for both the Henvey Inlet First Nation and surrounding region.

In addition to the direct and indirect job opportunities, spin off benefits will be gained from Henvey Inlet Wind's revenues. How the profits are used will be solely up to the Band, meaning the Chief, Council and the Membership collectively.

Possibilities Include:

- » Expanded Band services, especially in areas of: Health, Education, Elder Services and Support, Youth Services and Support, Language Instruction and Retention, and Housing;
- » Reinvestment in new research and development, and business development and expansion;
- » Payments directly to Band Members as a "dividend"; and
- » Subsidized hydro bills.

Community Benefits

The Henvey Inlet Wind Community Benefits Program will support the local economy by ensuring benefits to the region have lasting impacts. The Program specifically supports four key areas along the 90 km transmission line route. Over the first twenty years of operations, the Municipality of McDougal, Township of Seguin, Township of Carling and Township of the Archipelago will each receive \$1,000,000 to fund projects and initiatives that benefit the residents of these municipalities. Henvey Inlet Wind will also continue to support local communities in the region through sponsorships and donations.
