Improving the Land

Increased net farmed land on the property by 350 cuerdas by improving roads and irrigation to areas previously inaccessible.

Job Creation

Eight on-site personnel operate and maintain the facility. Pattern Energy prioritizes using local contractors and suppliers whenever possible.

Lasting Revenue

Provides more than \$1 million annually in lease payments to the Puerto Rico Land Authority, which owns the land on which the project is built. Over the first 35 years of operations, Santa Isabel Wind expects to pay more than \$47 million for land royalties and taxes. The facility has also made significant contributions to the Santa Isabel Medical Center.





Harnessing the Wind

Wind energy provides local and sustainable electricity to Puerto Rico's energy mix. Today's wind energy technologies deliver affordability and reliability, making wind an ideal energy source.

A 101 megawatt facility utilizing 44 Siemens Gamesa 2.3 MW turbines, Santa Isabel Wind provides safe, affordable, and renewable electricity to power the needs of more than 80,000 Puerto Ricans each year. The facility's output is sold to the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority under a 35-year Power Purchase and Operating Agreement. Santa Isabel Wind has been operational since December 2012.
