General Updates

We noted during the Community BBQ that we have been in the process of outreach for those hosting infrastructure and will wrap up this process in the coming weeks. In addition, we will provide advance notice prior to accessing your property with equipment. Last, many of you have asked, so we wanted to be sure to let you know an individualized estimated economic analysis will be forthcoming for all landowners hosting infrastructure on their property. Please keep in mind these estimates are subject to change based on final design. The letter will provide contact information for our Land Admin Team should you have any questions once received.

Finally, we would like to congratulate all the kids who participated in the county and state fairs. We enjoy seeing their hard work shine each year and watching them grow in their agricultural pursuits. We love supporting our NM youth at these events and have had the privilege of supporting dozens of kids this year.

SunZia Wind

As we progress into full construction, we are committed to providing you with regular updates on overall progress. We will approach construction on a project zone-by-zone basis. On the back is a map, construction update, and a schedule by zone of when we expect activities to occur in the northern and southern portions of the project.

SunZia Wind South

- Clearing, road, and laydown yard construction will be ongoing in areas north of NM 247 and Corona. This will include county road upgrades and new road construction on private and state land.
- Quarry activities are in progress to manufacture aggregate materials.
- Construction will continue to ramp up for substation and switch yards in the Torrance Road area.
- Foundation excavation and concrete work will ramp up in late 2023 in the area north of Corona.
- General site activity and number of personnel on-site will continue to increase through early 2024.

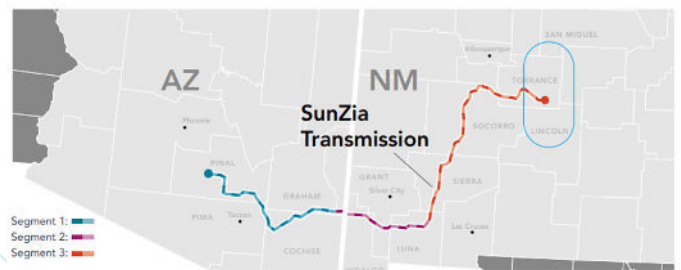
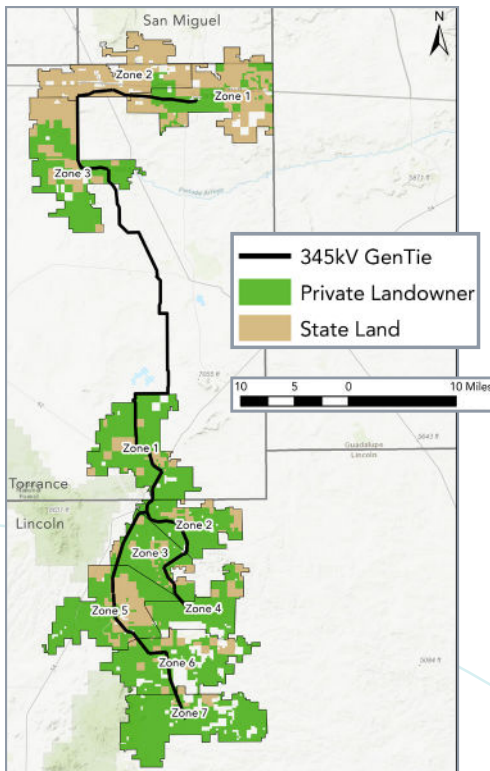

SunZia Transmission

We have officially begun work on the transmission line and are actively building roads and laydown yards and receiving structures and wire for the project. As you may have seen, on September 1 Secretary of the Interior Deb Haaland joined senior elected and government officials to initiate the project's groundbreaking at the SunZia East Converter Station. This event capped over 15 years of permitting work and has allowed for construction activities to commence. Work on the transmission line is broken down into three segments with activities beginning in each zone by separate crews.

SunZia Wind North

- Clearing and grubbing will start in January 2024.
- Quarry activities will start in January 2024 in Zone 3.
- All other activities will start in May 2024 in Zone 3 and ramp up through December 2024.
- Foundation excavation will commence in June 2024 in Zone 3.
