Happy Holidays from Pattern Energy. We hope you are enjoying the holiday season! Pattern continues to make progress on SunZia Transmission and is pleased to announce a few important project milestones, provide several updates regarding construction, and provide a recap on our community and environmental investments this year in this landowner newsletter.



Construction has begun on all three segments of the transmission line.

Construction across the transmission line will take place over the next two years by segment, with a forecasted completion by end of 2025. Please see the attached segment maps of the entire route of the SunZia Transmission project for reference.

High-level overview of the progress the SunZia Team has made to-date:

- Completed laydown yards for construction equipment and materials along the entire route.
- Full mobilization of construction crews along the entire route as of October 1st.
- Crews have begun preparing the transmission corridor for construction including staking and grading work as well as salvaging native plants including agave and saguaro.
- Crews are now starting to build transmission tower foundations, and to deliver and assemble tower structures.

Here is what to expect in 2024:

- Plant salvage work along all segments of the route will be completed in Q1 2024.
- Foundation work completed in late 2024 for Segments 2 & 3 and continue into early 2025 for Segment 1.
- Tower structure installation along all segments will commence in 2024 and continue into 2025.
- Stringing of conductor on tower structures will begin in Q2 2024 and continue into 2025.





2023 Community Engagement Recap

SunZia Transmission is being developed with a deep commitment to local communities and environmental stewardship. SunZia Transmission proudly contributed to numerous local organizations, causes, and events through its Community Engagement program in 2023. Here are some highlights:

- Pattern sponsored several county fairs along the route this year in New Mexico including Valencia,

 - At most of these county fairs, Pattern made donations to the buyers' pools. Pattern also attended and purchased cattle at the New Mexico State Fair.
- Pattern made donations to organizations such as Memory Keepers for families impacted by Alzheimer's, Boys and Girls Club, Gila Valley Soccer, Duncan Pride Society, Southwest Black Ranchers and Southeast Arizona Livestock Expo.




