SunZia Wind Construction

Construction on SunZia Wind began in September of last year and is progressing on schedule. As a reminder, we are constructing the project on a Zone-by-Zone basis in the North and South. The following are construction start dates by zone. These dates may be adjusted based on work in the field. As you can see, construction is well underway in South Zones 1, 2, 3 and 4 and in North Zones 2 and 3.

Start of Construction by Zone

SunZia Wind South

Zone 1 & 2 September 2023

Zone 3 & 4 January 2024

Zone 5 & 6 May 2024

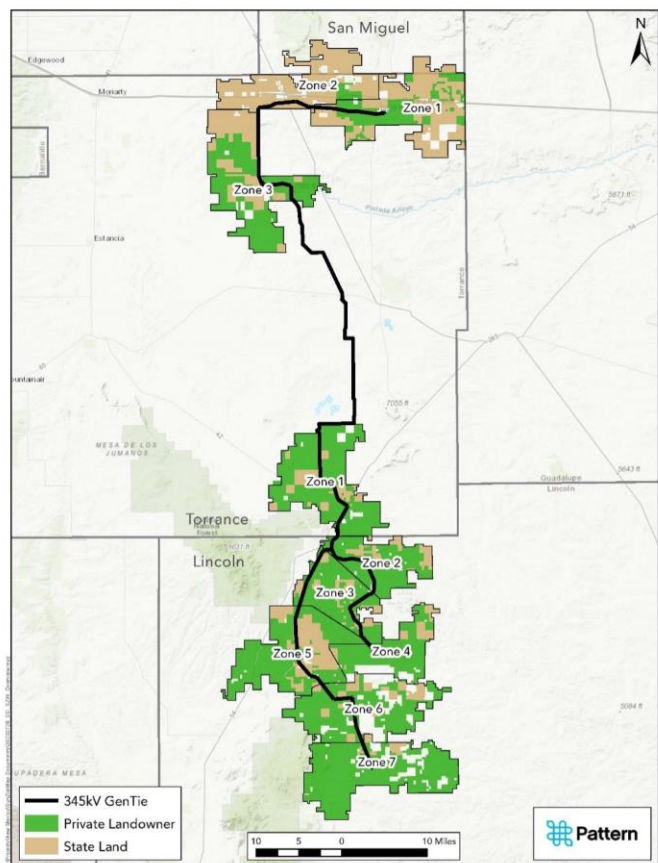
Zone 7 July 2024

SunZia Wind South

Torrance & Lincoln County

Construction crews are fully mobilized in Zones 1-4 with over 330 workers on-site. Here are a few construction milestones:

- Over 170 wind turbine foundations have been poured
- Construction of the overhead transmission and collection lines has begun
- Installation of the underground collection system has begun
- Two main power transformers have been delivered

Here is the progress we have made on SunZia Wind South:

Clearing & grubbing: 70% complete

Access roads: 29% complete

Foundations poured: 25% complete

Wind turbines erected: 0% complete

UG collection system installed: 13% complete

Gen-tie structure installed: 13% complete

Substation completion: 7% complete

Finally, turbine tower deliveries will begin in June and July. We are finalizing turbine delivery routes with GE and route information will be communicated to you.

SunZia Wind North

San Miguel & Torrance County

Construction crews are mobilized in Zones 2 and 3 with over 45 workers on-site. Civil work including clearing, grubbing and access road construction is underway. Wind turbine foundation pouring will begin in July 2024.

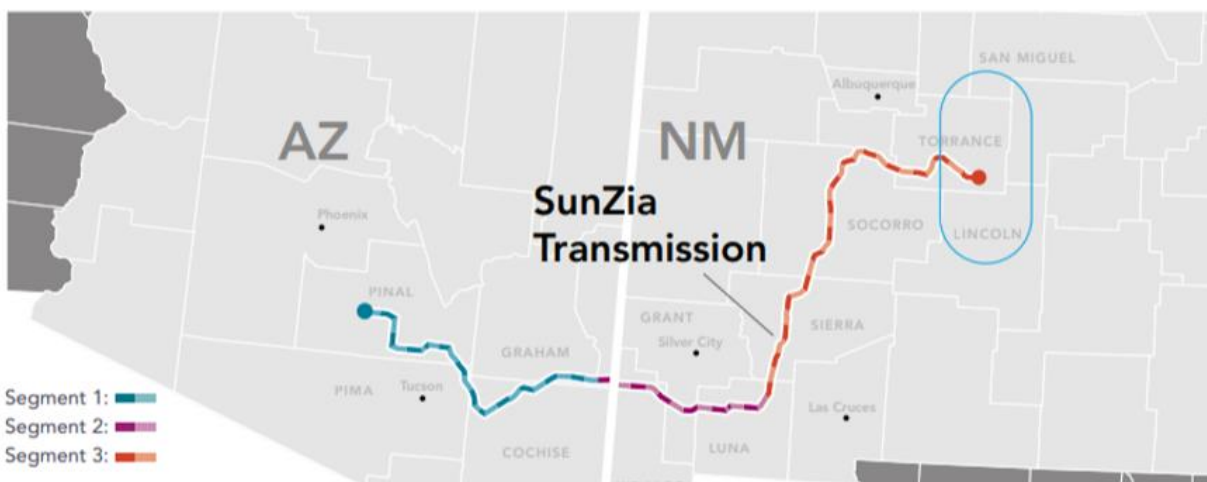
SunZia Transmission Construction

Work is well underway on SunZia Transmission across Arizona and New Mexico and progressing on schedule. Here are some high level milestones:

- Over 1,044 foundations have been completed
- Over 191 structures have been installed
- 3,500 saguaro cacti and 11,000 agave have been relocated
