

We're back with another update from SunZia and Pattern Energy. Summer is bringing big things for SunZia, including a nearly completed Transmission Line!



SunZia Transmission Construction

As projected, SunZia Transmission has erected **all** of the Arizona and New Mexico towers. Our stringing crews have also completed connecting all the power lines for these towers across the full SunZia Transmission project! This is a huge milestone.

We've also finished building our three regeneration stations and are working install hardwire power in them. Finally, we're starting on the important environmental work of site reclamation, and seeding has begun in Arizona.

Here is the progress update on SunZia Transmission:

Pad grading: 100% complete

Foundations: 100% complete

Anchors Installed: 100% complete

Structures Assembled: 100% complete

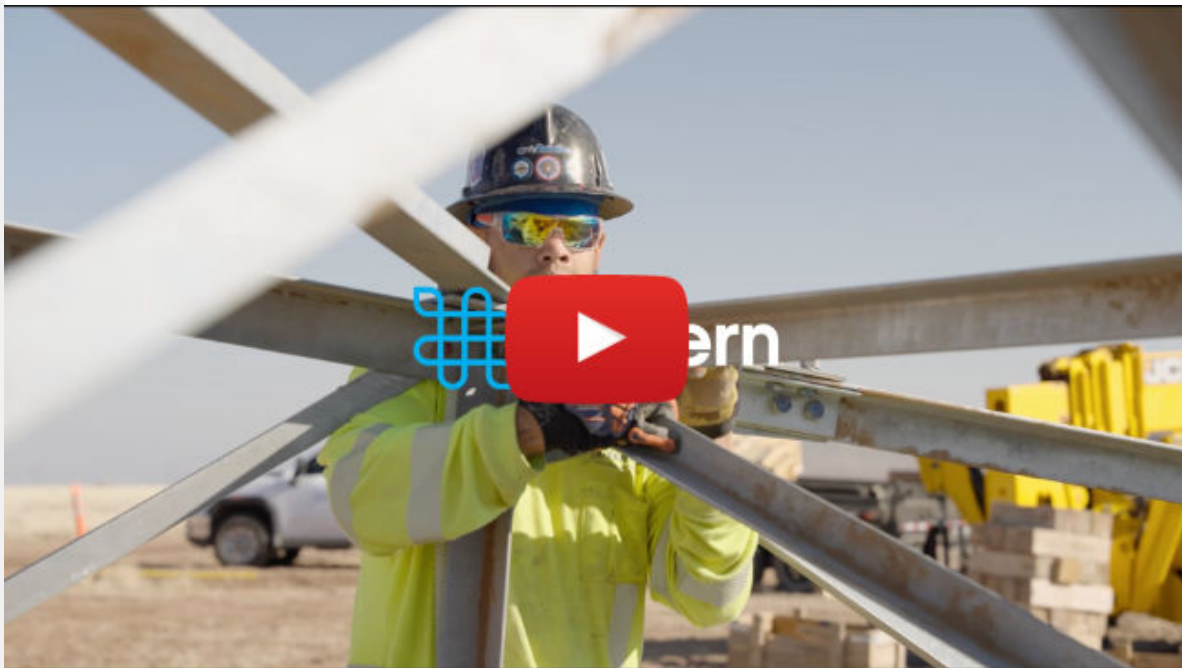
Structures Erected: 100% complete

Stringing—: 100% complete

Regeneration stations: All three are built, and have been hardwired for power

What Goes Into Building A Transmission Tower?

SunZia Wind Construction

Construction on SunZia Wind continues. The first wind turbines are going up, and many more are being delivered. Here is an overview of our progress of SunZia Wind South and North.

SunZia Wind South Zone construction milestones include:

Clearing & grubbing: 100% complete

Access roads: 95% complete

Foundations excavated: 90% complete

Foundation pours complete: 79% complete

Foundations backfilled: 76% complete

Wind turbines delivered: 58% complete

Wind turbines erected: 27% complete

Wind turbines complete: 182 of 674

Underground collection system installed: 58% complete

Overhead collection structure installed: 42% complete

Stringing: 47% complete

Substation completion: 77% complete

SunZia Wind North Zone construction milestones include:

Clearing & grubbing: 100% complete

Access roads: 99% complete

Foundations poured: 100% complete

Foundations excavated: 100% complete

Foundations backfilled: 100% complete

Wind turbines delivered: 48% complete

Wind turbines erected: 5% complete

Underground collection system installed: 53% complete

Overhead collection structure installed: 33% complete

Stringing: 26% complete
