



NOTICE OF PROCEEDING AND HEARING

Ancho Wind LLC, Cowboy Mesa LLC, Dahlia Wind LLC, Gallinas Mountain Wind LLC, Lobo Power LLC, Pastura Wind LLC, Viento Loco LLC, and Pattern S C Holdings LLC, (collectively, the “Joint Applicants”) filed an Application with the New Mexico Public Regulation Commission on May 27, 2026, proposing to expand the wind generation in New Mexico with the construction of the Corona Wind North II Project.

The project consists of up to 3,200 MW of wind generation and associated facilities. The generation components of the project will be located on approximately 432,000 acres of land, including approximately 328,000 acres of private land and approximately 104,000 acres of state land. The length of the Corona Wind North II Gen-Tie System is 176.9 miles. The project is, or will be, owned and operated by Pattern Energy and its affiliated entities, including the Joint Applicants.

To produce the desired energy, the Joint Applicants anticipate that the generation will consist of 750 wind turbines with a nameplate capacity of at least 3.8 MW or greater. Each turbine will be connected by 34.5kV collection lines to new substations to be located within the Corona Wind North II Project area. The Project is expected to be constructed in phases, with the earliest in-service date by the end of 2029.

In the Application, the Commission is asked to grant the following approvals, on an expedited basis, without a hearing if no valid protests are filed by July 27, 2026:

1. Approve the area for the location of the wind turbines and related facilities for the Corona Wind North II Generation.
2. Approve the proposed route for the 345-kilovolt of the Corona Wind North II Gen-Tie System.
3. Provide the necessary approvals, to the extent required by law, for the 200-foot right-of-way (ROW) width for the Corona Wind North II Gen-Tie System which is the subject of the Application.

A PARTY, PROTEST OR COMMENT ON THE APPLICATION**

The major events for public participation in this matter will occur as follows:

- Deadline to file motions to intervene to become a party: July 27, 2026
- Deadline to file protests: July 27, 2026

- Deadline to file intervenors' direct testimony: August 24, 2026
- Deadline to file rebuttal testimony: September 4, 2026
- Public evidentiary hearing: September 28, 2026, 9 a.m.

NOTE: If a protest is filed regarding the Right of Way Width Authorization, then additional deadlines specific to that authorization will be established, including testimony and public hearing deadlines.

THESE ARE NOT ALL THE DEADLINES SET FORTH IN THIS MATTER, AND PARTIES AND POTENTIAL INTERVENORS ARE ADVISED TO READ THE COMPLETE PROCEDURAL ORDER ISSUED ON JUNE 16, 2026.
